MEETING DATE: September 13, 2022

We have three public hearings on the agenda, as follows:

The first involves the 2023 Schedule of Values, Standards and Rules that will be used for the upcoming tax reappraisal of real property. The board received copies of these documents at the August regular meeting. A copy of the notice of public hearing will be included in the packet and it was published in the August 24, 2022 edition of *The Franklin Press* and the August 25, 2022 edition of *The Highlander*.

Per Tax Administrator Abby Braswell, the board, by statute (NCGS 105-317), must wait at least seven days after the public hearing before adopting the final schedules, standards and rules. She will be at the meeting to answer questions or provide additional details.

The second public hearing involves the proposed “no wake zone” in the Little Choga Cove area of Nantahala Lake. A copy of that notice is also included, and it appeared in the August 31, 2022 edition of *The Franklin Press*.

Following the close of the public hearing, the board can act to approve a “Resolution of Macon County Board of Commissioners Requesting that the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission Undertake Rulemaking for the Purpose of Establishing a New ‘No Wake Zone’ in the Little Choga Cove Area of the Nantahala Lake for the Purpose of Mitigating Hazards to Water Safety.” A copy of that resolution will be included in the packet, along with a letter from Chairman Tate to the Wildlife Resources Commission, the application for water safety rulemaking and Exhibit A to the application which specifically denotes the area to be regulated.

County Attorney Eric Ridenour and County Planning Director Joe Allen can provide additional detail as needed.

The third and final public hearing involves the annual hearing regarding the Macon County Community Transportation Program Application, or more specifically, Section 5311 (ADTAP), 5310, 5339, 5307 and applicable state funding, or combination thereof. A copy of the public notice will be included in the packet. Please note that this hearing is in connection with funding for Macon County Transit for the period of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024. As you will note on the public hearing notice, the local share for this timeframe is \$132,891, and that amount would come from a combination of county general funds and contract revenue. Transit Director Darlene Asher can provide more detail and answer questions at the meeting. The application must be submitted to the North Carolina Department of Transportation no later than October 7, 2022, and a copy of the "FY 2024 Local Share Certification for Funding" form is included in the packet for your review.

WAKE ZONE” IN THE LITTLE CHOGA COVE AREA OF THE NANTAHALA LAKE
FOR THE PURPOSE OF MITIGATING HAZARDS TO WATER SAFETY**

THAT WHEREAS, the Little Choga Cove area of the Nantahala Lake located in Macon County, North Carolina contains thirty-one docks and two community docks and is the location where many resident and visiting swimmers, boaters, kayakers, and paddle boarders occupy the area simultaneously, including many children.

WHEREAS, Macon County has determined that a “no wake zone” is needed in the Little Choga Cove area of the Nantahala Lake in order to afford sufficient protection to those who occupy that area of the lake and to mitigate hazards to water safety in the area of the lake as set forth in the application, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, Macon County respectfully requests that the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission undertake rulemaking for the purpose of establishing a new “no wake zone” in the Little Choga Cove area of Nantahala Lake in Macon County, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Macon County has duly advertised a Notice of Public Hearing to be held on September 13, 2022, at 6:00 o’clock p.m., in The Franklin Press on _____, and _____, in connection with this matter as required by the provisions of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 75A-15; and

WHEREAS, Macon County did hold a Public Hearing in connection with such request on September 13, 2022, at 6:00 o’clock p.m., in the Commissioners’ Board Room in the Macon County Courthouse located at 5 West Main Street, Franklin, NC 28734, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 75A-15 to:

- A. Discuss and approve the making of a formal application and recommendation by Macon County, North Carolina to the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission for it to adopt a local rule establishing a new “no wake zone” and/or speed restrictions applicable within the Little Choga Cove area of Nantahala Lake located in Macon County, North Carolina;
- B. Request special rules and regulations for the waters described above;
- C. Request full implementation of the U.S. Aids to Navigation System in all waters within Macon County, North Carolina; and

- D. Make application to the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission for the regulations being proposed as referenced above.

WHEREAS, during such Public Hearing, various comments from the Public were duly received and noted by the Macon County Board of Commissioners regarding the proposals set forth hereinabove.

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of Commissioner _____, seconded by Commissioner _____, and duly approved, be it hereby resolved that:

1. The Macon County Commissioners do hereby specifically and formally:
 - A. Approve the making of a formal application and recommendation by Macon County, to the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission for it to adopt a local rule establishing a new “no wake zone” and/or speed restrictions applicable within the Little Choga Cove area of Nantahala Lake located in Macon County, North Carolina in accordance with the Application, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference;
 - B. Request special rules and regulations for the waters described above;
 - C. Request full implementation of the U.S. Aids to Navigation System in all waters within Macon County, North Carolina; and
 - D. Make application to and request action from the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission for the regulations being proposed as referenced above.
2. Macon County does hereby respectfully and formally request that the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission undertake Rule Making for the purpose of establishing a new “no wake zone” in the Little Choga Cove area of Nantahala Lake in Macon County, North Carolina, for the purpose of mitigating hazards to water safety;

Enclosed please find Macon County’s Application for a new “no wake zone” local rule or regulation on the Little Choga Cove area of Nantahala Lake in Macon County, North Carolina.

The new “no wake zone” is identified in the Proposed Regulation attached to the enclosed Application and such area is formed by connecting the three coordinates listed in Exhibit A of the Application.

The Notice of Public Hearing was published in The Franklin Press on August 31, 2022. A copy of the Notice of Public Hearing is enclosed herewith for your reference. The actual public hearing in connection with this matter was held at 6:00 o’clock p.m., in the Commissioners’ Board Room of the Macon County Courthouse, 5 West Main Street, Franklin, NC 28734.

Macon County estimates that four items will need to be purchased to mark the new “no wake zone,” which are two nine-inch buoys and two buoy anchors. The four items are expected to cost a total of \$951.33. Macon County will purchase these items, and the homeowners will reimburse the county.

Exhibit A to Application

RECOMMENDED MODIFICATION TO MACON COUNTY LOCAL REGULATION 15A
NCAC 10F .0366 WOULD INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING UPDATE:

- (a) Regulated Area. This Rule shall apply to the following waters of Nantahala Lake:
- (1) Lakes End Cove west of SR 1310 otherwise known as Wayah Road in Topton, shore to shore north of a line from a point on the west shore at 35.19602 N, 83.64184 W to a point on the east shore at 35.19544 N, 83.64053 W; and
 - (2) the area within 100 yards of a point at 35.16570 N, 83.64686 W at the end of the Mountain Shadows Community dock, in Topton; and
 - (3) the mouth of Little Choga Cove formed by connecting the coordinates from shore to shore at 35.18482 N, 83.67390 W; 35.18482 N, 83.67346 W; and 35.18482 N, 83.67437 W.
- (b) Speed Limit. No person shall operate a vessel at greater than no-wake speed in the waters of the regulated area specified in Paragraph (a) of this Rule.
- (c) Placement of Markers. The Board of Commissioners of Macon County shall be designated agency for placement of the markers implementing this Rule.

REQUIREMENTS NECESSARY FOR REGISTRATION AS AN ENVIRONMENTAL
HEALTH SPECIALIST OR ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH SPECIALIST INTERN.**

WHEREAS, the Macon County Department of Health and Human Services has a shortage of Environmental Health Specialists and is unable to meet the demand to issue On-site Waste Water and Water Well permitting; and

WHEREAS, the lack of qualified Environmental Health Specialists has resulted in a backlog of applications for On-site Waste Water and Well Permitting, which has resulted in untimely construction delays; and

WHEREAS, the need for Environmental Health Specialist is critical to the construction industry and local economy; and

WHEREAS, the inability to fill the Environmental Health Specialist position has had and is having a crippling effect on the local economy; and

WHEREAS, the Macon County Board of Commissioners believe that the job qualifications required by the State of North Carolina to become a certified Environmental Health Specialist pursuant to N.C.G.S. §90A-53 are too strict and must be revised before further damage is done to the local economy.

NOW THEREFORE, upon Motion of Commissioner _____,
seconded by Commissioner _____, and duly approved, be it
hereby resolved by the Macon County Board of County Commissioners as follows:

1. That the job qualifications required by the State of North Carolina to become a certified Environmental Health Specialist as required under N.C.G.S. §90A-53(a)(3)(a) be revised to remove the requirement of “one or more years of experience in the field of environmental health practice.”
2. That the job qualifications required by the State of North Carolina to become a certified Environmental Health Specialist as required under N.C.G.S. §90A-53(a)(3)(b) be revised to:
 - a. Reduce the minimum of 30 semester hours or its equivalent in the physical and biological sciences to 15 semester hours, and
 - b. Remove the requirement of “two or more years of experience in the field of environmental health practice.”

3. That the job qualifications required by the State of North Carolina to become a certified Environmental Health Specialist as required under N.C.G.S. §90A-53(a)(3)(c) be revised to:
 - a. Reduce the minimum of 30 semester hours or its equivalent in the physical and biological sciences to 15 semester hours, and
 - b. Remove the requirement of “two or more years of experience in the field of environmental health practice.”
4. That the job qualifications required by the State of North Carolina to become a certified Environmental Health Specialist as required under N.C.G.S. §90A-53(a)(3) be revised to allow for a person who has graduated with an Associate’s Degree from a Community College or Junior College that is accredited by the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC) and has completed 15 semester hours or its equivalent in the physical and biological sciences.
5. That the job qualifications required by the State of North Carolina to become a certified Environmental Health Specialist as required under N.C.G.S. §90A-53(a)(3) be revised to allow for a person who has graduated with an Associate’s Degree from a Trade School that is accredited by the Accrediting Council for Continuing Education and Training (ACCET) and has completed 15 semester hours or its equivalent in the physical and biological sciences.

RESOLVED, that Macon County requests and pleads that that the North Carolina General Assembly amend the requirements necessary to become a certified Environmental Health Specialist pursuant to N.C.G.S. §90A-53 be amended as stated herein, effective immediately.

Dear Mr. Roland:

Duke Energy is proposing to make important system improvements at 11099 and 11015 Buck Creek Road. We plan to construct a new overhead power line to improve power quality in the area. This work will include the placement of one new pole as shown on the enclosed drawing. As you see, the power line presently passes over Buck Creek Road twice and goes to a pole in the middle which is situated up on a bank which is difficult to access. The line passing over the road is not the preferred method of installation as if there happen to be a line breakage it falls in the road. The preferred approach to this application is as the drawing indicates (circled in GREEN).

Before Duke Energy can construct the planned improvements, permission in the form of an easement is needed from the affected property owner. The easement allows Duke Energy to access your property to complete the desired construction and maintain the improvements going forward. I have included a copy of the easement agreement along with a sketch depicting the location of the proposed infrastructure, for your review and consideration.

Duke Energy has contracted with Southeastern Land Company to work on behalf of the company to secure the required easement. If you do not have any questions regarding this matter, you may execute and have notarized the enclosed easement agreement and return to me in the enclosed envelope.

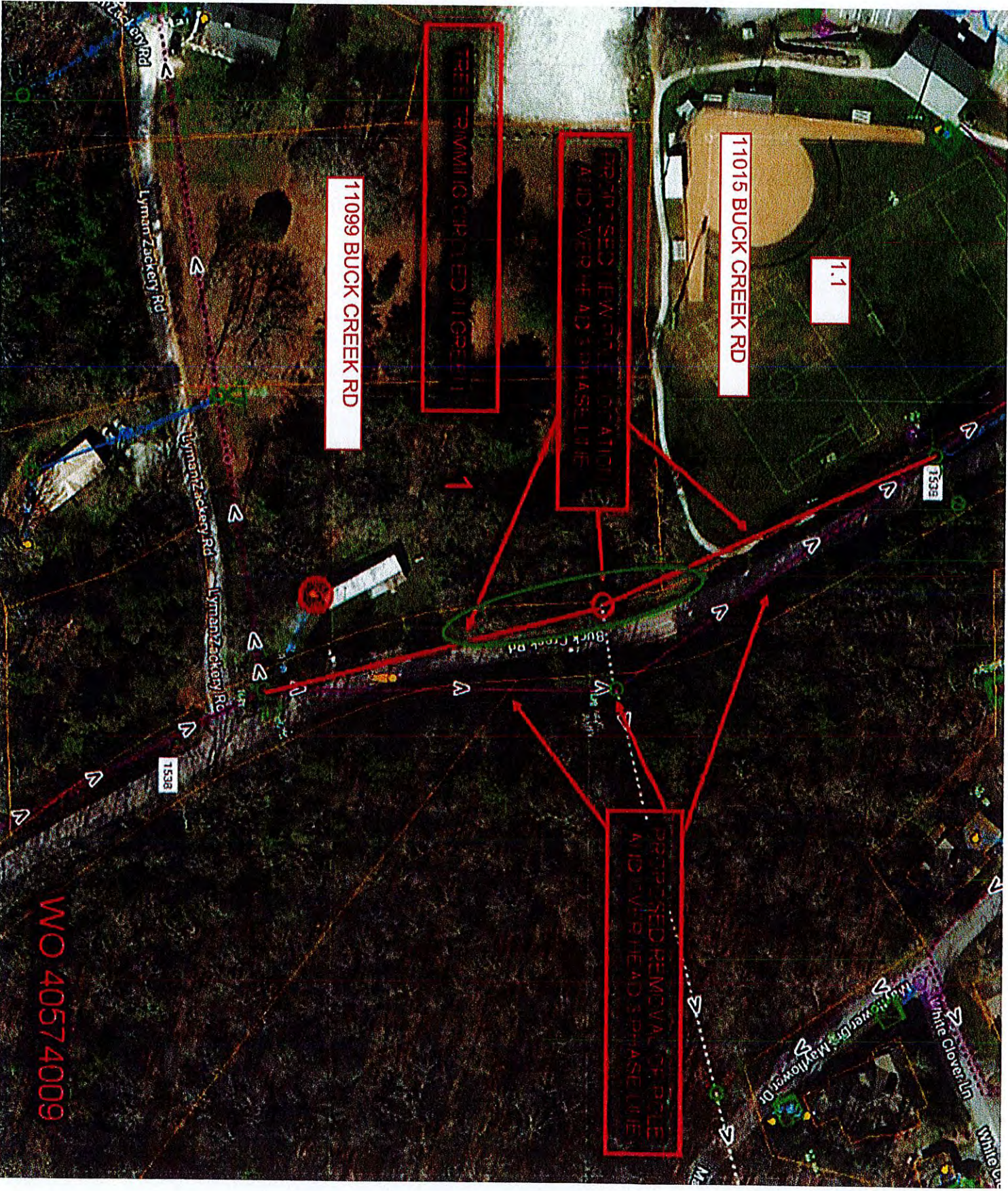

EASEMENT

THIS EASEMENT ("**Easement**") is made this ____ day of _____ 20____, from **MACON COUNTY**, a body corporate and politic organized under the laws of the State of North Carolina ("**Grantor**", whether one or more), to **DUKE ENERGY CAROLINAS, LLC**, a North Carolina limited liability company ("**Grantee**").

Grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of One and 00/100 Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant unto Grantee a perpetual and non-exclusive easement, to construct, reconstruct, operate, patrol, maintain, repair, replace, relocate, add to, modify, and remove electric and communication lines including, but not limited to, all necessary supporting structures, and all other appurtenant apparatus and equipment for the transmission and distribution of electrical energy, and for technological purposes related to the operation of the electric facilities and for the communication purposes of Incumbent Local Exchange Carriers (collectively, "**Facilities**").

Grantor is the owner of that certain property described in that instrument recorded in Deed Book K-40, Page 2106, and Deed Book J-23, Page 1941 Macon County Register of Deeds ("**Property**").

The Facilities may be both overhead and underground and located in, upon, over, along, under, through, and across a portion of the Property within an easement area described as follows:

A strip of land forty feet (40') in uniform width for the overhead portion of said Facilities and a strip of land twenty feet (20') in uniform width for the underground portion of said Facilities, lying equidistant on both sides of a centerline, which centerline shall be established by the center of the Facilities as installed, along with an area ten feet (10') wide on all sides of the foundation of any Grantee enclosure/transformer, vault and/or manhole, (hereinafter referred to as the "**Easement Area**").

For Grantee's Internal Use:
Work Order #: 40574009

The rights granted herein include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Grantee shall have the right of ingress and egress over the Easement Area, Property, and any adjoining lands now owned or hereinafter acquired by Grantor (using lanes, driveways, and adjoining public roads where practical as determined by Grantee).
2. Grantee shall have the right to trim, cut down, and remove from the Easement Area, at any time or times and using safe and generally accepted arboricultural practices, trees, limbs, undergrowth, other vegetation, and obstructions.
3. Grantee shall have the right to trim, cut down, and remove from the Property, at any time or times and using safe and generally accepted arboricultural practices, dead, discased, weak, dying, or leaning trees or limbs, which, in the opinion of Grantee, might fall upon the Easement Area or interfere with the safe and reliable operation of the Facilities.
4. Grantee shall have the right to install necessary guy wires and anchors extending beyond the boundaries of the Easement Area.
5. Grantee shall have the right to relocate the Facilities and Easement Area on the Property to conform to any future highway or street relocation, widening, or alterations.
6. Grantor shall not place, or permit the placement of, any structures, improvements, facilities, or obstructions, within or adjacent to the Easement Area, which may interfere with the exercise of the rights granted herein to Grantee. Grantee shall have the right to remove any such structure, improvement, facility, or obstruction at the expense of Grantor.
7. Excluding the removal of vegetation, structures, improvements, facilities, and obstructions as provided herein, Grantee shall promptly repair or cause to be repaired any physical damage to the surface area of the Easement Area and Property resulting from the exercise of the rights granted herein to Grantee. Such repair shall be to a condition which is reasonably close to the condition prior to the damage, and shall only be to the extent such damage was caused by Grantee or its contractors or employees.
8. The rights granted in this Easement include the right to install Facilities wherever needed on the Property to serve future development on the Property and neighboring lands. Portions of the Facilities may be installed immediately and other portions may be installed in the future as the need develops. Facilities installed in the future shall be installed at locations mutually agreeable to the parties hereto if they are to be located outside of the Easement Area. Upon any future installations of Facilities at mutually agreed locations, the Easement Area shall be deemed to include such future locations at the widths defined in this Easement.
9. All other rights and privileges reasonably necessary, in Grantee's sole discretion, for the safe, reliable, and efficient installation, operation, and maintenance of the Facilities.

The terms Grantor and Grantee shall include the respective heirs, successors, and assigns of Grantor and Grantee. The failure of Grantee to exercise or continue to exercise or enforce any of the rights herein granted shall not be construed as a waiver or abandonment of the right thereafter at any time, or from time to time, to exercise any and all such rights.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said rights, privilege, and easement unto Grantee, its successors, licensees, and assigns, forever. Grantor warrants and covenants that Grantor has the full right and authority to convey to Grantee this perpetual Easement, and that Grantee shall have quiet and peaceful possession, use and enjoyment of the same.

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN THE
TOWN COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF FRANKLIN AND THE
MACON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
CONCERNING ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY AND EXTENSION OF THE
LITTLE TENNESSEE GREENWAY**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners for Macon County, as the governing board for the County of Macon (the "County"), is the owner of and maintains the Little Tennessee Greenway (the "Greenway"). The Greenway is located within and extends through the corporate limits of the Town of Franklin (the "Town,");

WHEREAS, the Town, acting through its Town Council, now has the opportunity to acquire from Mainspring Conservation Trust, Inc., a parcel of real property located on the waters of Cartoogechaye Creek, being Macon County PIN 6594-02-0614, described in Deed Book X-37, pages 1072-1075 of the Macon County Public Registry (the "Mainspring Tract"); and

WHEREAS, the Town is willing to acquire the Mainspring Tract and pursue funding for construction of an extension to the Greenway, crossing the extension of the Greenway across the said tract (the "Project"), in exchange for the County's commitment to maintain and manage the said extension of the Greenway, as described in this Memorandum of Understanding (the "MOU"),

NOW THEREFORE, the Town and the County now desire, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. Chapter 160A, Article 20 and as otherwise permitted by law, to enter into this MOU to set forth Their joint understanding of each party's intention with respect to the Project.

1. The Town will enter into an offer to purchase and sale agreement for the Mainspring Tract. The agreement will be subject to such due diligence and other conditions precedent as the Town shall deem wise.
2. The parties will pursue funding sources for purposes of the Project from sources including but not necessarily limited to grant funding from the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund (PARTF). The parties agree to act as joint applicants where necessary. Upon receipt or commitment of sufficient funds for the Project, the parties agree to cooperate to cause it to be constructed, extending the Greenway from its current endpoint on that property located at 77 Siler Farm Road, Macon County PIN 6594-00-4624 to the contiguous boundary of the Mainspring Tract, and continuing along Cartoogechaye Creek as the parties shall jointly determine. The parties may supplement this Agreement with an agency agreement whereby one party is appointed the other's agent for purposes of constructing the Project, with full authority to enter onto the property of the other party for such purposes.
3. Following completion of the Project, the County agrees to be responsible for maintenance, upkeep, and security of the extended Greenway, in its discretion.

MINUTES

Vice-Chairman Beale called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. All Board Members (with the exception of Chairman Tate), County Manager Derek Roland, Deputy Clerk Mike Decker, Finance Director Lori Carpenter, County Attorney Eric Ridenour and members of the news media were present, as were Highlands Mayor Patrick Taylor, Franklin Mayor Jack Horton, as well as a number of county employees and citizens.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- (A) Vice-Chairman Beale explained that Chairman Tate is out of town.
- (B) Vice-Chairman Beale announced that he and Mr. Roland would be attending the North Carolina Association of County Commissioners (NCACC) meeting later this week, and would have a report at the September meeting.
- (C) Vice-Chairman Beale announced that a resolution regarding wastewater would be presented at the September regular meeting and then presented to the NCACC on behalf of Commissioner Higdon.

MOMENT OF SILENCE: Vice-Chairman Beale asked that the family of Josh Orr be remembered. Mr. Orr was a volunteer firefighter who recently lost his life while swimming. Vice-Chairman Beale requested that all in attendance rise and a moment of silence was observed.

PLEDGE TO THE FLAG: Led by Deputy Clerk Mike Decker, the pledge to the flag was recited.

PUBLIC HEARING(S): None

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: **John deVille** spoke about the Franklin High School project. He thanked the commissioners, the Macon County Board of Education, Mr. Roland and Macon County Schools Superintendent Dr. Chris Baldwin for their leadership and guidance in paving the way for two key leadership bodies to speak in one voice. He said he had heard two views from the opposing side. First, that the proposed facility and property are too small and secondly the desire to have no tax increase. **Jim Strauss** spoke about a safety issue with a cove on Choga Creek off of Nantahala Lake due to the absence

of a “no wake free zone.” He requested the board address the issue and pass a resolution creating one. **Dylan Castle** shared questions he has regarding the proposed Franklin High School project and requested the board share information about previous properties that have been considered, how the number of planned students was calculated as well as plans for maintenance and upkeep of the new facility. **Town of Highlands Mayor Patrick Taylor** spoke in support of the proposed plans for Franklin High School and acknowledged the support the project shows for investing in the future of the children of Macon County. He stated he was publically endorsing the building of the new school. **Tom Oswalt**, President of the Nantahala Community Club, spoke in support of the quarter-cent sales tax increase to support building the new school.

ADDITIONS, ADJUSTMENTS TO AND APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA: Upon a motion by Commissioner Shields, seconded by Commissioner Young, the board voted 4-0 to approve the agenda as presented.

REPORTS AND PRESENTATIONS: None

OLD BUSINESS: None

NEW BUSINESS:

(A) Request to increase Clerk of Court/Facilities budget – Macon County Clerk of Superior Court Shawna Thun Lamb presented a budget request to purchase desks, chairs for the public, desk chairs and shelving units for storage for the clerk’s office in the Macon County Courthouse in the amount of \$5,700. Upon a motion by Commissioner Shields, seconded by Commissioner Young, the board voted 4-0 to amend the budget to transfer funds from contingency to cover the purchases.

(B) Molar Roller Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) funding request – Macon County Public Health Director Kathy McGaha stated that the Molar Roller is 19 years old and had an original life expectancy of 10 years. She shared that at 15 years of age, it underwent a partial refurbishment with an expected gain of five additional years. Ms. McGaha provided a PowerPoint presentation, which is attached [Attachment 1] and is hereby made a part of these minutes, sharing statistics regarding children under the age of 19 who are served by the Molar Roller. She indicated the average number of visits between 2013 and 2019 were 9,370 per year. Buildings and Grounds Director Mike Cope described the current problems with moving and setting up the unit, including controls not working, hydraulic leaks and inoperable jacks. He said the unit weighs approximately 8,700 pounds and the next move will have to be the final move with a permanent location at Mountain View Intermediate (MVI) School. Ms. McGaha stated it currently takes about two years to get a new unit, and some vendors

offer a payment plan allowing for the unit to be paid for over the two-year period. She indicated she is looking for grant opportunities, as well as utilizing Medicaid Cost Settlement funds and reassignment of county funds to cover the cost of the unit. After a brief discussion, Commissioner Young made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Shields, to open the bidding process to assess the cost and look at funds the health department can contribute, and the vote was 4-0.

(C) Announcement of demonstration dates for new voting equipment –

Board of Elections Director Melanie Thibault gave an update on the request for new voting equipment. She stated the request was first made a couple of years ago as the current equipment is over 20 years old and has exceeded its use. Ms. Thibault indicated that Macon County is one of only five counties in the state who do not have current equipment and explained the process that must be carried out before purchasing the new machines: 1) Witness a public demonstration of two different voting systems, 2) Board of Elections recommends purchase of voting system equipment, 3) Board of Elections has to test the new system and equipment in a specific precinct or a simulated election, 4) Board of Commissioners has to make a resolution to purchase the equipment and 5) the North Carolina State Board of Elections approves the purchase. She shared dates for the public demonstrations of August 23, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. for Elections Systems and Software (ES&S), and August 30, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. for Hart InterCivic, Inc. with both demonstrations to be held at the Robert C. Carpenter Community Building. Ms. Thibault indicated the goal is to purchase the equipment in 2023 and have it ready to use in the municipal election in November 2023. She said the department currently have 22 machines and will be requesting to purchase twenty-four at an estimated cost of \$250,000.

(D) 2023 Schedule of Values, Standards and Rules –

Tax Administrator Abby Braswell provided a PowerPoint presentation and reviewed reappraisal data on property sales by township. She shared that in 2021 there were 1,853 total qualified sales and in 2022 there have been 815 qualified sales and we are half-way through the year. Additionally, Ms. Braswell shared that in 2019 the taxable value was \$7,969,346,695 and is estimated to be at \$12,029,130,971 in 2023 – a 50.94 percent increase. She stated that she will provide another snapshot in January and requested the proposed Schedule of Values, Standards and Rules be slated for a public hearing at the regular meeting scheduled for September 13, 2022 and then approved/adopted in accordance with NCGS §105-317 at the regular meeting scheduled for October 11, 2022. There was a consensus among the board members to accept the schedule as presented.

(E) Update on one-quarter-cent county sales and use tax – Commissioner Shields provided an update from the Franklin High School Project Committee and thanked those in attendance who were here to support the project. He indicated the next public meeting to look at the schematic design is tentatively scheduled for October. Mr. Roland stated there is a need for \$100 million-plus to fund the new high school. He indicated the application to the North Carolina School Fund requesting \$50 million last fiscal year was not successful and there are plans to resubmit the application in November. He reminded the board of the approval of the quarter-cent sales tax on the November ballot and that the resolution that was passed says if the ballot passes, the funds can be used for the new high school. Mr. Roland also clarified that this proposed increase does not affect the purchase of groceries and gas. He shared a brochure that has been developed to provide citizens with information about the quarter-cent initiative as well as the question as it will appear on the November ballot. Vice-Chairman Beale shared that he attended the Rebounding Stronger Summit in Cherokee today and stated that Governor Roy Cooper and other key leaders were present. He stated there was a lot of discussion about grants and other funds that are available, and that Macon County needs to be prepared to apply for these grants and funds when they become available. Vice-Chairman Beale also stated that the ballot will not and cannot contain language regarding how the funds will be spent from the quarter-cent sales tax, and that the board cannot vote to support or not support the quarter-cent sales tax. However, Vice-Chairman Beale stated the board could budget those funds to be spent specifically for the high school project.

(F) Franklin High School Project – Mr. Roland stated that, following the July 26, 2022 joint meeting with the Macon County Board of Education, he and Mr. Ridenour were instructed to enter into negotiations with LS3P for Phase III for the schematic design of the main building, which has been completed, via an addendum to the current contract in the amount of \$476,161. He said these funds were part of the approximate \$800,000 appropriated in the FY '23 budget. The board then took the following action:

(1) Resolution of Amendment to Agreement between Macon County and LS3P Associates, Ltd. - Vice-Chairman Beale read part of the resolution into the record, followed by a motion by Commissioner Shields, seconded by Commission Young, to approve the resolution as presented. The vote was 4-0.

(2) Second Amendment to Owner-Architect Agreement – There was a motion by Commissioner Young, seconded by Commissioner Shields, to approve the addendum to the LS3P agreement, and the vote was 4-0.

CONSENT AGENDA: Upon a motion by Commissioner Young, seconded by Commissioner Shields, the board voted 4-0 to approve the consent agenda as presented, which includes: (A) Minutes of the June 14, 2022 regular meeting and the July 26, 2022 continued session, (B) Budget Amendments #15-27, (C) Tax releases for the month of July (None), and (D) Monthly ad valorem tax collection report – for which no action was necessary.

TAX COLLECTIONS:

The Tax Collections Office staff consists of a Tax Collection Supervisor, and two (2) Deputy Tax Collectors, all of whom are certified through the North Carolina Tax Collectors Association. The collection procedure involves processing payments through checks, cash and electronic payments. Property owners may pay their taxes through the mail, phone-based transactions, on-line, in person and through a secure drop-off box located in front of the annex building. Many accounts are also paid through an electronic process utilized by escrow companies, service companies and by Auto-Agent, which is a software program that mortgage/escrow companies utilize in order to eliminate 98% of refunds.

The collections office staff utilizes diligent effort to collect both the current year taxes and any delinquent taxes. Collection of the current year taxes involves the processes as mentioned above as well as a lockbox service, which is provided through the Wells Fargo bank. This service involves Wells Fargo staff electronically processing payments, with a report provided to the office staff daily, with payments processed and balanced by the collections staff on the same day. In addition, this staff works closely with escrow companies, service companies and Auto-Agent to electronically process payments that are forwarded each year. As always, we process payments on-site, and service many property owners who pay directly through our office.

We have increased the use of enforced collections through this office in recent years. Enforced collections involve processes utilized to collect delinquent taxes. These processes include: garnishment of bank accounts, garnishment of Department of Revenue returns, garnishment of rents or other dollars held by a third party, and as a last resort, the foreclosure process.

As noted above, the foreclosure process is now utilized in this office with successful results. We contract with attorney Kelly Ball, of Ridenour & Goss to handle our foreclosures. The mortgage style foreclosure process is utilized, resulting in a much more efficient process, with attorney involvement throughout. This process is initiated with a demand letter for payment, which regularly results in payment without any other part of the process being utilized. In my opinion, the inclusion of this process is necessary to insure that the tax collections rate is kept at the maximum amount achievable.

Prior to enforced collections being utilized, a property owner is notified by billings in July of each year, second notices which are mailed in January of each year, advertisement in the newspaper which is scheduled for March of each year, and various other communications that are mailed directly from this office. Processes for payment also include pre-payments, which allow a property owner to divide his or her tax bill into twelve (12) "pre-payments" prior to the bill being issued or partial payments after the bills are issued and prior to the delinquency date.

Processing and balancing of fund collection reports are issued to the finance office on a daily, monthly, and yearly basis.

The increase in the use of enforced collections and other collection procedures has resulted in the tax collection rate being over 98% for the past three (3) years, with the 2021 collection rate being 98.94%.



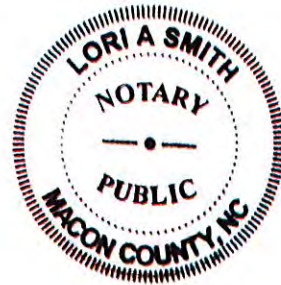



This is patient debts that need to be written off and needs to go to the Commissioners for approval.

Attached you will find copies of the outstanding debt to be written off. The Board of Health approved these debts to be written off at the Board of Health meet that took place on July 26, 2022, by unanimous vote.

We have been in the process of cleaning up old delinquent accounts and accounts that are uncollectable. The largest number of accounts that have been uncollectable have been with DataMax and are still outstanding. DataMax has been unable to collect; therefore, we would like to write off these accounts and get them off our books. Accounts range from 2003 through 2017. We have no information on most of these accounts, due to the accounts were initially set up in our old system HIS. The HIS system is now obsolete and the state has deactivated all access to this system. I can assume these accounts were from regular services and Adult Dental.

The next document includes accounts from COVID-19 testing that were patients without insurance. Due to the State of Emergency Pandemic these fees for COVID-19 testing are unbillable because HRSA funding was cutoff. This document also includes patient bills from untimely filing, flu vaccines, and accounts where contact information is no longer valid. We have not been able to turn anyone over to collections because of the current SOE. That changes 8/15.


